Communicate important updates related to the camp.

Improve the functionality and user experience of the System.

We do not sell or rent your information to third parties. However, we may share your information in the following ways:

Project Partners: With key project partners involved in the execution and evaluation of the camp.

Service Providers: With third-party vendors who assist us in hosting and maintaining the System.

Legal Obligations: If required by law or to protect the rights and safety of the project, volunteers, or participants.
